In order to access this program, you will need a program card to present to the park kiosk. These cards are available for you to acquire at the Behavioral Health Services building front desk between 8-5, Monday-Friday. Please bring proof of residency. If you already have a card that you were using for Senior Soak in previous years, that card is still valid. If you have misplaced your card, you may come in and get a new card.
